## TITLE IX SEXUAL HARASSMENT FORMAL COMPLAINT

Robert Russa Moton Charter School maintains a firm policy prohibiting all forms of harassment. All persons are to be treated with respect and dignity. This form is for students, employees, and applicants to use to file a formal complaint of sexual harassment covered by Title IX. Title IX prohibits discrimination in education on the basis of sex. Title IX sexual harassment is defined as conduct on the basis of sex that meets one or more of the following: 1) An employee of the Robert Russa moton Charter School conditioning the provision of an aid, benefit or service of the Robert Russa Moton Charter School on an individual's participation in unwelcome sexual conduct; 2) Unwelcome conduct determined by a reasonable person to be so severe, pervasive, and objectively offensive that it effectively denies a person equal access to the Robert Russa Moton Charter School education program or activity; or 3) Sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, or stalking.
